



When making countertop selections for an outdoor area, it is important to consider materials that can withstand sun exposure, extreme temperature fluctuation, standing water, and other natural elements (dirt, pollen, etc). We offer a variety of stone options that are fantastic choices for outdoor installations.

NATURAL STONE: Granite and Soapstone are both resilient enough to hold up to the elements. We recommend against installing Marble outdoors, and Quartzite only if the area is shaded from direct sunlight. Marble is porous and will stain easily, while the resins used in Quartzite quarrying can yellow over time with sun exposure.

ULTRA COMPACT SURFACE/PORCELAIN: There are a number of brands on the market that produce ultra compact/sintered stone and porcelain slabs. These come in a variety of colors and designs made to mimic other materials (natural stone, concrete, etc), but without the worry of maintenance. They are extremely durable and often come in slip-resistant finishes that can be used as outdoor flooring.

OUTDOOR RATED QUARTZ: Caesarstone has developed a line of 3 quartz colors that are manufactured without the resins that are problematic for installation of traditional quartz surfaces outdoors.




